Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In Death Valley, California, an area known as the Racetrack Playa has captured people's interest for years. The playa is a flat lakebed some three miles long and



extremely flat. Every now and then, rocks on the surface of the lakebed leave tracks, as if they

moved! As it turns out, these sliding stones are driven by strong wind when the surface of the ground is slightly wet or frozen. Catching these stones in the act, though, has been devilishly tricky, and it seems few have actually been able to see them actually moving. Some have referred to them as 'living stones.'

In his first letter, Peter also refers to 'living stones,' but in a much different context. The recipients of that letter, a young Christian community living in what is now modern day Turkey, were having difficulty. They were facing opposition and hardship due to their faith in Jesus, and some were teetering on the edge of turning away from the faith.

Peter, who was also known as 'The Rock', wrote to encourage these people and told them a couple of really remarkable things that we still find encouraging and instructional today. "You, also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." (1 Pet 2:5) There is a lot in this little verse worth exploring.

First, Christians back around the year 60. when this was written, did not have temples of their own. Jesus' resurrection was only 30 years prior, so Christianity was still in its infancy and they didn't have the massive temples (or even modest church buildings) like their Gentile friends who worshipped Aphrodite, Zeus, and the like. Nor did they have anything that rivaled Jewish temple in Jerusalem. The reason this was such a problem was that up until then, people thought God, or gods, met people at their temple! Temples were where gods dwelt, and a city that had a temple was protected and purified by that particular god. Peter, however, shows that we are God's temple. When God wants to meet a city, protect a people, or purify a nation, he starts with *us*!

Further, Peter calls them and us a holy priesthood. This means that, in addition to being little mobile temples everywhere we go, we also perform the functions of a priest and should conduct ourselves accordingly, living holy and dedicated lives. We are to offer God praise, and also to lead others to do the same.

As Christians, we are living stones,

to be used by God. As we are built into little mobile spiritual houses, we allow God to speak to others through us, and to protect and



purify a nation. Be holy, as God intends!


