Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"We hold these truths to be selfevident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness."

Words to live by.

These words provide the foundation of the opening salvo of the Revolutionary War, the Declaration of Independence. We see in this quote that in this dark and frightening time in American history, faith in God was important to the Founders right from the outset. Christianity has always been important to the US, and the country has been blessed because of its relationship with God.

But it is worth examining this paragraph in greater detail. Specifically of note are the phrases 'self-evident,' 'created equal,' and 'endowed by their Creator.'

Thomas Jefferson, who put pen to paper when writing this document, was not fighting for racial equality, as we are today. Nor were any of those Founding Fathers. No, they were striving to remove the British king and his influence from the Colonies. When they used the phrase, 'created equal,' they were attacking the notion of Divine Right, the idea that the King's right to rule came straight from God. Part of the absolute genius of the phrase, however, was that it was specifically crafted *so that it could be used* in the inevitable struggle against slavery and racism. All humans are

created *equal*, and this fact is obvious; it is self-evident.

Equally obvious is the notion that humanity's Creator, God, built in certain rights. There is a Creator, and it is obviously so. And because God created all of us, not just the King, certain rights. Not the right to rule, as was being claimed by the monarch, but the right to life and freedom.

This 4th of July, take time to remember what a blessing it is to live in the US, and remember that as Christians, we are called to be blessings to others both as individuals and as a country.
